AN ACT CONCERNING THE REVISION OF THE HARBOR MANAGEMENT ACT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

Section 1. Section 22a-113p of the general statutes is repealed and the
following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 (a) The commission may review and make recommendations, 4 consistent with the plan, on any proposal affecting the real property on, 5 in or contiguous to the harbor that is received by any zoning 6 commission, planning commission or combined planning and zoning 7 commission, zoning board of appeals, historic district commissions, 8 flood prevention, climate resilience and erosion control board, harbor 9 improvement agency, port authority, redevelopment agency, shellfish 10 commission, sewer commission, water pollution control authority or 11 special district with zoning or other land use authority. Such agencies 12 shall send a copy of any such proposal to the commission upon the 13 request of such commission. The commission shall be notified of any 14 such proposal [at least] not later than thirty-five days [prior to] before 15 the commencement of the hearing thereon or where no hearing is held, 16 [at least] not less than thirty-five days [prior to] before the taking of any

17 final action on the proposal. The local agency authorized to act on the 18 proposal shall consider the recommendations of the commission. A two-19 thirds vote of all the members of the local agency [having] that has 20 authority to act on the proposal shall be required to approve a proposal 21 [which] that has not received a favorable recommendation from the 22 commission, provided [that] the provisions of this section shall not be 23 deemed to alter the authority of the agency [having] that has primary 24 jurisdiction over the proposal to deny, modify or condition the proposal. 25 Failure of the commission to submit a recommendation shall be deemed 26 to be approval of the proposal.

27 (b) The commission may review and make recommendations, 28 consistent with the plan, on any application for a permit or license to be 29 issued by the state for a proposal that may affect the harbor and that is 30 received by the Department of Energy and Environmental Protection or 31 any other state agency with authority in the harbor. The department or other state agency, as applicable, shall require that an applicant or 32 33 registrant for such permit or registration, as applicable, consult with the 34 commission prior to submittal of such an application or registration to the department or other state agency, as applicable, and that any such 35 36 applicant or registrant for any such permit or license concomitantly 37 provide a copy of any such application or registration to the commission 38 when such application or registration is submitted to the department or 39 other state agency, as applicable. The department or other state agency authorized to act on any submitted application or registration shall 40 consider the recommendations of the commission made pursuant to the 41 42 plan. Any recommendation of the commission that is consistent with 43 and adequately supported by the content of the plan, as described in 44 section 22a-113n, with respect to any such application or registration 45 shall be binding on the department or other state agency, as applicable, when making regulatory decisions or undertaking or sponsoring 46 47 development affecting the area within the commission's jurisdiction unless such department or other state agency, as applicable, shows 48 49 cause, in writing, why a different action should be taken. Failure of the commission to submit a recommendation shall be deemed a 50

- 51 determination by the commission of consistency of such application or
- 52 <u>registration with the plan.</u>

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
