AN ACT PROHIBITING PUBLIC SERVICE COMPANIES FROM RECOVERING LOBBYING COSTS AND CERTAIN OTHER COSTS FROM RATEPAYERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 16 of the general statutes be amended to prohibit public
- 2 service companies from recovering in rates any costs associated with
- 3 lobbying, membership in a trade association or other nonbusiness
- 4 activities, including charitable giving.

Statement of Purpose:

To prohibit public utilities from recovering lobbying costs, trade association dues and charitable donations from their ratepayers.
