AN ACT CREATING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY INCREASED ACCOUNTABILITY AND COMPETITION IN THE ELECTRIC DISTRIBUTION MARKET.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to create a task force to study (1) how the market serviced by each electric distribution company may be reconstituted in order to be more accountable to ratepayers and more responsive to ratepayer needs, and (2) the introduction of competition in the electric transmission or distribution services industry in Connecticut.

Statement of Purpose:

To study the consumer benefit of increased accountability and competition in the electric distribution market.
