## AN ACT CONCERNING STATE ELECTIONS ENFORCEMENT COMMISSION INVESTIGATIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to provide that (1) the 2 State Elections Enforcement Commission shall, not later than sixty days 3 after the filing of a complaint (A) conclude any investigation of such 4 complaint; and (B) issue a dismissal or resolution of such complaint, and 5 (2) in the event said commission finds no violation and dismisses such complaint, the existence of such complaint shall not be referenced in any 6 7 electioneering communication opposing the candidate who was the 8 subject of such complaint.

## Statement of Purpose:

To (1) require an election complaint to be resolved not later than sixty days after filing, and (2) in the case of an elections enforcement case closed due to a finding of no violation, prohibit the use of such case in any electioneering communication against the candidate who was the subject of such case.
