AN ACT INSTITUTING RANKED-CHOICE VOTING FOR MUNICIPAL, STATE AND FEDERAL ELECTIONS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 9 of the general statutes be amended to establish in each
- 2 election for a municipal, state or federal office a method of casting and
- 3 tabulating votes whereby electors rank candidates in order of
- 4 preference, tabulation proceeds in sequential rounds in which last-place
- 5 candidates are defeated and the candidate with a majority of the votes
- 6 in the final round is elected.
