AN ACT CONCERNING THE STATE'S REGULATED CANNABIS MARKETS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 21a of the general statutes be amended to: (1) Address
- 2 quality control and safety issues stemming from the amounts of mold
- 3 and bacteria that may be present in marijuana sold as part of the state's
- 4 palliative-use marijuana program; (2) address the mold and bacteria
- 5 remediation methods currently allowed under the state's palliative-use
- 6 marijuana program; (3) create a more robust palliative-use marijuana
- 7 caregiver program for the state through employment of a multi-tier
- 8 classification system; (4) establish special permits that enable cannabis
- 9 vendors to sell cannabis at, and event organizers to organize, various
- 10 events; (5) allow hemp products produced in this state to be sold in
- 11 dispensaries; and (6) provide for more micro-cultivator and dispensary
- 12 licenses for qualified residents and business owners.
