AN ACT ALLOWING IN-STATE TUITION AT PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION FOR REFUGEES AND ASYLUM SEEKERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10a-29 of the general statutes be amended to allow
- 2 students who are refugees, asylum seekers or recipients of other types
- 3 of humanitarian visas to qualify for in-state tuition at public institutions
- 4 of higher education.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow refugees, asylum seekers and recipients of other kinds of humanitarian visas to qualify for in-state tuition at public institutions of higher education.
