AN ACT CONCERNING LIABILITY FOR THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL OR PROFESSIONAL USE OF AUTOMATIC EXTERNAL DEFIBRILLATORS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (a) of section 52-557b of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to protect licensed physicians and other health care
- 3 providers who use automatic external defibrillators in the ordinary
- 4 course of their employment or practice from civil liability when the
- 5 automatic external defibrillator malfunctions.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect physicians and other health care providers who use automatic external defibrillator in the ordinary course of their employment or practice from civil liability when the automatic external defibrillator malfunctions.
