AN ACT INCREASING INCOME AND ASSET LIMITS FOR MEDICAID WAIVER PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 17b of the general statutes be amended to increase asset
- 2 limits to ten thousand dollars for an individual and fifteen thousand
- 3 dollars for a couple and income limits to one hundred thirty-eight per
- 4 cent of the federal poverty level for Medicaid waiver programs.

Statement of Purpose:

To ensure all Connecticut residents have equal access to critical medical and long-term care benefits under Medicaid waiver programs while retaining enough to help cover home repairs, car repairs, rent increases and other emergencies.

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
