AN ACT CONCERNING THE DEVELOPMENT OF PROTOCOLS TO PREVENT THE TRANSMISSION OF INFECTIOUS AND COMMUNICABLE DISEASES IN SCHOOLS DURING A PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require, during a 2 declaration of a public health or civil preparedness emergency by the 3 Governor, the Commissioner of Education to (1) develop and 4 implement, in conjunction with the Commissioner of Public Health and 5 the Secretary of the Office of Policy and Management, state-wide protocols that are designed to prevent the transmission of infectious or 6 7 communicable diseases in school buildings, and such protocols shall 8 include, but need not be limited to, the cleaning of school buildings and 9 the upgrading or retro-commissioning of heating, ventilation and air 10 conditioning projects, and (2) apply to the United States Department of 11 Education for a waiver from federal student assessment requirements.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for safe and successful schools and prevent infectious and communicable disease transmission in school buildings in the event of a public health emergency.
