AN ACT LOWERING THE AFFORDABLE HOUSING APPEALS THRESHOLD IN MUNICIPALITIES THAT PROVIDE AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUNDING.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subsection (k) of section 8-30g of the general statutes be
- 2 amended to lower the affordable housing appeals threshold from ten
- 3 per cent to five per cent in any municipality that provides funding for
- 4 affordable housing developments.

Statement of Purpose:

To enable towns that financially encourage affordable housing to meet affordable housing goals established by section 8-30g of the general statutes.
