AN ACT REQUIRING THE STUDY OF INCREASED ELECTRICITY DELIVERY RATES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 16 of the general statutes be amended to require the Public
- 2 Utilities Regulatory Authority to study causes for increased electricity
- 3 delivery rates and make recommendations for lower delivery rates and
- 4 increased consumer choice.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority to study the increased delivery rates and make recommendations for lower delivery rates and increased consumer choice.
