AN ACT CONCERNING MATHEMATICS CLASSES AT PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to eliminate the requirement
- 2 to take advanced mathematics classes for students with academic
- 3 majors unrelated to industries that utilize mathematics.

Statement of Purpose:

To eliminate the requirement to take mathematics classes if a student's major is unrelated to an industry which uses mathematics.
