AN ACT CONCERNING THE MINIMUM AGE TO BE ELIGIBLE TO MARRY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 46b-20a of the general statutes be amended to require
- 2 that a person be not less than eighteen years of age to be eligible to
- 3 marry.
