AN ACT PRECLUDING A PERSON CONVICTED OF A CRIME INVOLVING DOMESTIC VIOLENCE FROM SEEKING ALIMONY FROM A SPOUSE WHO WAS THE VICTIM OF SUCH VIOLENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 46b-82 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 a person who is convicted of a crime involving domestic violence be
- 3 precluded from seeking alimony from a spouse who was the victim of
- 4 such violence.

Statement of Purpose:

To preclude a person convicted of a crime involving domestic violence from collecting alimony from the spouse who was abused by such person.
