AN ACT REQUIRING PRESENTATION OF PHOTO IDENTIFICATION TO VOTE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 9-261 of the general statutes be amended to provide that,
- 2 prior to receiving and being able to cast a ballot at the polling place, each
- 3 elector shall present to the official checker or checkers a current and
- 4 valid photo identification, which identification clearly displays such
- 5 elector's name and residential address.

Statement of Purpose:
