AN ACT CONCERNING THE REASSESSED VALUE OF A RESIDENTIAL BUILDING WITH A FOUNDATION MADE WITH DEFECTIVE CONCRETE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended (1) to allow the owner of a residential building with a foundation made with defective concrete, for which the owner has received a reassessment in accordance with the provisions of section 29-265d of the general statutes, to request that the reassessed value of such building apply retroactively to the date such owner purchased or received such building, and (2) to require municipalities to grant such request.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow an owner to request and require a municipality to apply retroactively the reassessed value of a residential building with a foundation made with defective concrete to the date such owner purchased or received such building.
