AN ACT CONCERNING THE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH WORKFORCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapters 383a, 383b and 383c of the general statutes be amended
- 2 to reduce barriers to licensure for behavioral health professionals who
- 3 have met the educational requirements for associate licensure.

Statement of Purpose:

To expand the behavioral health workforce by eliminating barriers to licensure for newly graduated clinicians.
