AN ACT REQUIRING A STUDY TO DETERMINE IF COMPETENCY TESTING FOR CERTIFIED NURSE'S AIDES, PHLEBOTOMISTS AND ELECTROCARDIOGRAPHY TECHNICIANS SHOULD BE OFFERED IN OTHER LANGUAGES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 To require the Department of Public Health to study whether 2 competency testing for certified nurse's aides, phlebotomists and 3 electrocardiography technicians should be offered in languages other 4 than English.
