AN ACT EXTENDING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS IN FAILURE TO REPORT CHILD ABUSE OR NEGLECT CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to extend the statute of
- 2 limitations for the criminal prosecution of a violation of failure to report
- 3 child abuse or neglect as a mandated reporter to five years from the time
- 4 the mandated reporter is informed of, suspects, or has reason to believe
- 5 abuse may have occurred, or is occurring.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide for a longer period to prosecute failure to report child abuse or neglect in order to strengthen protections for children.
