AN ACT CONCERNING ANXIETY SCREENING FOR CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 19a of the general statutes be amended to require anxiety
- 2 screening for any person between the ages of eight and eighteen at such
- 3 person's annual physical examination.
