## AN ACT CONCERNING ELIGIBILITY FOR UNEMPLOYMENT BENEFITS AND SEASONAL AGRICULTURAL BUSINESSES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 567 of the general statutes be amended to (1) update the
- 2 base wage threshold triggering eligibility for employment benefits, (2)
- 3 adjust such base wage threshold annually based on inflation, and (3)
- 4 exempt agricultural employers from participation in the unemployment
- 5 compensation system unless their employees satisfy the base wage
- 6 threshold for at least two consecutive quarters in a calendar year.

## Statement of Purpose:

To update the basis on which unemployment benefits will be required to be paid and protect seasonal agricultural businesses from disproportionate taxation.
