AN ACT CONCERNING THE VISIBILITY OF PRIVATE DELIVERY SERVICE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 3 conforms to the minimum specifications established by the American
- 4 National Standards Institute when delivering items in the course of
- 5 employment.
