AN ACT CONCERNING LONG-TERM CARE FACILITY RESIDENTS' USE OF COMMUNICATION DEVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require that long-term care
- 2 facilities allow residents to use communication devices in their rooms to
- 3 remain connected with their loved ones and to permit family caregivers
- 4 to participate as members of the resident's care team.
