AN ACT REQUIRING THE STATE TO FULLY FUND SPECIAL EDUCATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 164 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 state to fully fund the cost of providing special education to all students
- 3 in the state and to eliminate the requirement for matching funding
- 4 requirements from local or regional boards of education for such
- 5 purpose.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the state to fully fund special education for the purposes of providing equal education opportunity to all special needs students in the state.
