AN ACT CONCERNING SEIZURE-SAFE SCHOOLS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to (1) require school
- 2 personnel to complete a seizure recognition and first-aid response
- 3 training, (2) mandate that a seizure action plan be made part of the file
- 4 of any student at-risk for seizures and be made available to all school
- 5 personnel and volunteers responsible for such student, (3) ensure that
- 6 any medication approved under the provisions of the federal Food,
- 7 Drug and Cosmetic Act and prescribed by a treating physician is
- 8 administered to the student prescribed such medication, and (4) require
- 9 education and training of students about epilepsy and first-aid
- 10 response.

Statement of Purpose:

To require training, education and planning regarding seizures to ensure the safety of children with epilepsy.

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
