AN ACT PREVENTING COMMUNITY GUN VIOLENCE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish an organizational
- 2 initiative within state government, tasked with implementing evidence-
- 3 based, community-centric programs and strategies, in lieu of or in
- 4 partnership with existing community organizations, with the goal of
- 5 reducing street level gun violence in the state's largest urban areas and
- 6 those areas most effected by gun homicides.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish an initiative to prevent community gun violence.
