**AN ACT ESTABLISHING ELECTION DAY AS AN OFFICIAL STATE
HOLIDAY.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 1-4 of the general statutes be amended to designate as a
- 2 legal holiday the Tuesday after the first Monday in November and to
- 3 remove either Lincoln Day or Washington's Birthday as a legal
- 4 holiday.

Statement of Purpose:

To establish election day as an official state holiday for the purpose of
voting.
