AN ACT REDUCING EXCESSIVE NOISE FROM MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That sections 14-80 and 14-80a of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 require the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles, after notice and an
- 3 opportunity for a hearing, to suspend the registration of any motor
- 4 vehicle that is the subject of two or more written warnings or violations
- 5 of subsection (b) of section 14-80 of the general statutes or subsection (a)
- 6 of section 14-80a of the general statutes within a period of six months.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce excessive noise from motor vehicles that are the subject of two or more written warnings or violations within a period of six months by suspending the registrations of such motorcycles.
