AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN SOLAR WORKERS TO OBTAIN A LICENSE TO PERFORM ELECTRICAL WORK.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 393 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 no person may install a solar project that is capable of generating at least
- 3 one megawatt of electricity unless such person has first obtained a
- 4 license to perform electrical work.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that no person may install a solar project that is capable of generating at least one megawatt of electricity unless such person has first obtained a license to perform electrical work.
