AN ACT PROHIBITING GOVERNMENT ENTITIES FROM TRACKING PASSENGER MOTOR VEHICLES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to prohibit any government entity
- 2 from using an automated number plate recognition system and
- 3 maintaining a record, including a video, that identifies the time and
- 4 location of the operation of a passenger motor vehicle, except that the
- 5 Department of Correction or a law enforcement agency may use such
- 6 system and maintain such records in the investigation of a crime.

Statement of Purpose:

To protect personal privacy by prohibiting a government entity from tracking passenger motor vehicles.
