AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF THE AVAILABILITY OF HEALTH INSURANCE COVERAGE TO IMMIGRANTS IN THIS STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Insurance
2 Commissioner shall conduct a study concerning the availability of
3 health insurance coverage to individuals in this state who are unable to
4 establish legal presence in the United States or present a valid Social
5 Security number.

6 (b) Not later than December 31, 2019, the commissioner shall submit
7 a report, in accordance with section 11-4a of the general statutes, on the
8 results of such study to the joint standing committee of the General
9 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to insurance.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	New section
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Statement of Purpose:

To require the Insurance Commissioner to study the availability of health insurance coverage to individuals in this state who are unable to establish legal presence in the United States or present a valid Social Security number.
