**AN ACT CONCERNING ACCEPTABLE FORMS OF PAYMENT FOR
RETAIL GOODS AND SERVICES.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 21a of the general statutes be amended to provide that no
- 2 person who offers or sells, at retail, any good or service to a consumer
- 3 in this state shall: (1) Refuse to accept cash as a form of payment for such
- 4 good or service; (2) post any sign stating that such person will not accept
- 5 cash as payment for such good or service; or (3) charge a higher price to
- 6 such consumer because such consumer uses cash to pay for such good
- 7 or service.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that no person who offers or sells, at retail, any good or
service to a consumer in this state shall refuse to accept cash as a form
of payment for such good or service, post any sign stating that such
person will not accept cash as payment for such good or service, or
charge a higher price to such consumer because such consumer pays in
cash.
