AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF AUTOMATIC DIRECT PAYCHECK DEPOSIT PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The Labor Commissioner shall
- 2 study whether employers with twenty-five or more employees should
- 3 automatically enroll their employees into direct paycheck deposit
- 4 programs and whether any such enrolled employees should have the
- 5 option to opt out of such programs and elect to be paid by either cash
- 6 or check.
- 7 (b) Not later than January 1, 2020, the Labor Commissioner shall
- 8 report the results of the study completed pursuant to subsection (a) of
- 9 this section, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the
- 10 general statutes, to the joint standing committee of the General
- 11 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to labor.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following
