AN ACT REGULATING RESIDENTIAL INTERNET SERVICE AS A PUBLIC UTILITY IN THE STATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That the general statutes be amended to require the regulation of all residential Internet service, by the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority, as a public utility in the state, including a requirement that all rate increases must be approved by the Public Utilities Regulatory Authority.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the regulation of all residential Internet service as a public utility in the state.
