AN ACT CONCERNING A STUDY OF MEDICAID-FUNDED STATE PROGRAMS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (Effective from passage) (a) The Commissioner of Social
- 2 Services shall conduct a study of Medicaid-funded state programs
- administered under Title XIX of the Social Security Act, as amended
- 4 from time to time. Such study shall include, but need not be limited to,
- 5 a report on: (1) Factors the commissioner deems pertinent to quality of
- 6 care; (2) whether there are any gaps in access by eligible residents; and
- 7 (3) whether any provisions of the programs need to be changed to
- 8 conform with requirements of the Patient Protection and Affordable
- 9 Care Act, P.L. 111-148, as amended from time to time.
- 10 (b) Not later than July 1, 2020, the commissioner shall report the
- 11 results of the study, in accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a
- of the general statutes, to the joint standing committees of the General
- 13 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to aging and human
- 14 services. Such report may include the commissioner's
- 15 recommendations for addressing any identified gaps in the provision
- 16 of Medicaid-funded state services and improving access to such

17 services.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
