AN ACT EXPANDING THE WAYS IN WHICH A BOARD OF EDUCATION MAY EXPEND ITS ALLIANCE DISTRICT GRANT FUNDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 10-262u of the general statutes be amended to allow a
- 2 local or regional board of education for a town designated as an alliance
- 3 district to have more flexibility on what goods and services it may
- 4 expend its alliance district grant funds.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow boards of education to use their alliance district funds on a more diverse set of expenses to support students.
