## AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO THE TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE PROVIDED AS PART OF THE AFTER SCHOOL GRANT PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 That subsection (e) of section 10-16x of the general statutes be 2 amended to require the Department of Education, for purposes of the 3 administering the after school grant program, to (1) partner with the 4 regional educational service centers to (A) monitor and evaluate after 5 school programs and activities, (B) conduct a comprehensive evaluation 6 of the effectiveness of after school programs and implementation of risk 7 assessments, (C) provide technical assistance and training to eligible 8 applicants, and (D) ensure that after school program activities are 9 aligned with state academic standards; and (2) retain seven and one-half 10 per cent of the amount appropriated for such administration.

## Statement of Purpose:

To make revisions to the technical assistance requirements under the after school grant program to align with federal requirements and to ensure accountability and the provision of quality services.
