**AN ACT CONCERNING THE INCLUSION OF PERSONAL FINANCE
EDUCATION AND A COURSE ON FINANCIAL LITERACY IN THE HIGH
SCHOOL CURRICULUM.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General
Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 10 of the general statutes be amended to require the
- 2 Department of Education to (1) conduct a study concerning the
- 3 inclusion of personal finance education as part of the mandatory high
- 4 school curriculum in the state, and (2) provide a state-wide financial
- 5 literacy course for students in grades eleven and twelve based on the
- 6 findings of such study.

Statement of Purpose:

To include personal finance education in the high school curriculum so
that students can learn financial literacy skills and have equitable access
to personal finance skills.
