## AN ACT CONCERNING THE NONDISCLOSURE OF CERTAIN COMMUNICATIONS BETWEEN TEACHERS AND STUDENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That part I of chapter 166 of the general statutes be amended to
- 2 exclude from the definition of public record and provisions of section 1-
- 3 210 of the general statutes any communication between a teacher and a
- 4 student regarding sensitive subjects, such as sexual orientation, gender
- 5 identity and race, that occur during school-sponsored activities.

## Statement of Purpose:

To protect public school teachers from FOIA requests pertaining to communications with students regarding sensitive subjects, such as sexual orientation, gender identity and race, that take place during school-sponsored activities.
