AN ACT PROHIBITING HEALTH INSURERS FROM USING A DOLLARS-PER-QUALITY ADJUSTED LIFE YEAR OR ANY SIMILAR MEASURE AS A THRESHOLD.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That title 38a of the general statutes be amended to provide that no
- 2 insurer, health care center, fraternal benefit society, hospital service
- 3 corporation, medical service corporation or other entity that delivers,
- 4 issues for delivery, renews, amends or continues a health insurance
- 5 policy in this state shall use a dollars-per-quality adjusted life year, or
- 6 any similar measure, as a threshold to determining whether such
- 7 insurer, center, society, corporation or entity will cover or recommend a
- 8 health care service or establish or modify an incentive or reimbursement
- 9 program.

Statement of Purpose:

To provide that no insurer, health care center, fraternal benefit society, hospital service corporation, medical service corporation or other entity that delivers, issues for delivery, renews, amends or continues a health insurance policy in this state shall use a dollars-per-quality adjusted life year, or any similar measure, as a threshold to determining whether

such insurer, center, society, corporation or entity will cover or recommend a health care service or establish or modify an incentive or reimbursement program.
