## AN ACT AUTHORIZING BONDS OF THE STATE FOR GRANTS-IN-AID TO NONPROFIT HEALTH AND HUMAN SERVICES PROVIDERS FOR CERTAIN CAPITAL AND INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the State Bond Commission be empowered to authorize the
- 2 issuance of bonds of the state in accordance with section 3-20 of the
- 3 general statutes, in principal amounts not exceeding in the aggregate
- 4 fifty million dollars, provided twenty-five million dollars of said
- 5 authorization shall be effective July 1, 2023, the proceeds of which shall
- 6 be used by the Office of Policy and Management for the purpose of
- 7 providing grants-in-aid to nonprofit health and human services
- 8 providers for renovations of existing facilities, construction of new
- 9 facilities, upgrades to information technology systems, alterations and
- 10 improvements in compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act,

11 improvements to energy systems and the purchase of vehicles.
