AN ACT LIMITING THE GOVERNOR'S EMERGENCY POWERS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

That sections 19a-131a and 28-9 of the general statutes be amended to (1) limit any declaration of public health or civil preparedness emergency to an initial duration of not more than sixty days, and (2) limit any subsequent extensions of such a declaration to not more than thirty days, and make any such extension subject to the approval of a two-thirds majority vote of each chamber of the General Assembly.

Statement of Purpose:

To limit the duration of the Governor's power to declare a public health or civil preparedness emergency and ability to extend such an emergency unilaterally.
