AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CONNECTICUT AGE-APPROPRIATE DESIGN CODE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to establish an age-appropriate
- 2 design code requiring businesses that provide online products and
- 3 services likely to be accessed by children under eighteen years of age to
- 4 adopt privacy and safety measures, including, but not limited to, default
- 5 privacy settings that offer the maximum level of privacy and clearly and
- 6 concisely worded privacy policies and terms of service.

Statement of Purpose:

To adopt a Connecticut Age-Appropriate Design Code that creates privacy and safety obligations for providers of online products and services accessed by children.
