AN ACT CONCERNING THE MINIMUM WAGE FOR PERSONS UNDER THE AGE OF EIGHTEEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That subdivision (5) of subsection (i) of section 31-58 of the general
- 2 statutes be amended to reduce the minimum wage rate for any person
- 3 under the age of eighteen years old, with the exception of emancipated
- 4 minors, to seventy-five per cent and eliminate the ninety-day limit of
- 5 such reduced minimum wage.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the minimum wage rate for persons under the age of eighteen and eliminate the ninety-day limitation on such reduced minimum wage.
