AN ACT CONCERNING EMPLOYERS AND EMPLOYEES' UNION MEMBERSHIPS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That chapter 557 of general statutes be amended to (1) make it a
- 2 discriminatory practice for employers to ask employees if they have
- 3 ever been a member of a labor organization, and (2) make the
- 4 Connecticut Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities the
- 5 agency responsible for the administration and enforcement of such
- 6 discriminatory practice.

Statement of Purpose:

To make it a discriminatory practice for an employer to ask an employee if they have ever been a member of a union.
