AN ACT CONCERNING ACCESSIBILITY OF MEDICAL DIAGNOSTIC EQUIPMENT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Commissioner of
- 2 Public Health to adopt regulations requiring each health care facility to
- 3 meet or exceed the technical standards for accessibility developed by the
- 4 federal Architectural and Transportation Barriers Compliance Board in
- 5 accordance with Section 4203 of the Patient Protection and Affordable
- 6 Care Act, P.L. 111-148, as amended from time to time, for medical
- 7 diagnostic equipment.

Statement of Purpose:

To require medical diagnostic equipment purchased by health care facilities to meet technical standards for accessibility by persons with disabilities.

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
