AN ACT CONCERNING IMPROPER CARE OF PATIENTS BY NURSING HOMES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to require the Department of
- 2 Public Health to take action against nursing homes that do not provide
- 3 proper care to their patients, including, but not limited to, by leaving a
- 4 patient in his or her own excrement, overmedicating a patient, not
- 5 properly apply braces to a patient or not feeding a patient properly.

Statement of Purpose:

To require the Department of Public Health to take action against nursing homes that do not provide proper care to their patients.
