AN ACT ALLOWING HAIRDRESSERS AND COSMETICIANS TO PRACTICE AS A NAIL TECHNICIAN WITHOUT OBTAINING A NAIL TECHNICIAN LICENSE OR TEMPORARY PERMIT.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to allow hairdressers and
- 2 cosmeticians licensed under section 20-252 of the general statutes on or
- 3 before January 1, 2021, to practice as a nail technician in the state without
- 4 being required to obtain a license or temporary permit as a nail
- 5 technician from the Department of Public Health under section 20-265d
- 6 or 20-265e of the general statutes.

Statement of Purpose:

To allow licensed hairdressers and cosmeticians to practice as a nail technician without a nail technician license or temporary permit.
