**AN ACT CONCERNING ADJUDICATION OF COMPLAINTS MADE AGAINST SEXTONS.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That section 7-66 of the general statutes be amended to provide that
- 2 (1) any person who wishes to file a complaint alleging that the sexton
- 3 of a cemetery has failed to comply with his or her statutory duties shall
- 4 file such complaint with the Probate Court where the cemetery is
- 5 located, and (2) the judge of such Probate Court may refer a complaint
- 6 alleging criminal wrongdoing by the sexton of cemetery to the state's
- 7 attorney.

**Statement of Purpose:**

To create a clear path for resolving complaints that allege that a sexton of a cemetery has failed to comply with his or her statutory duties.
